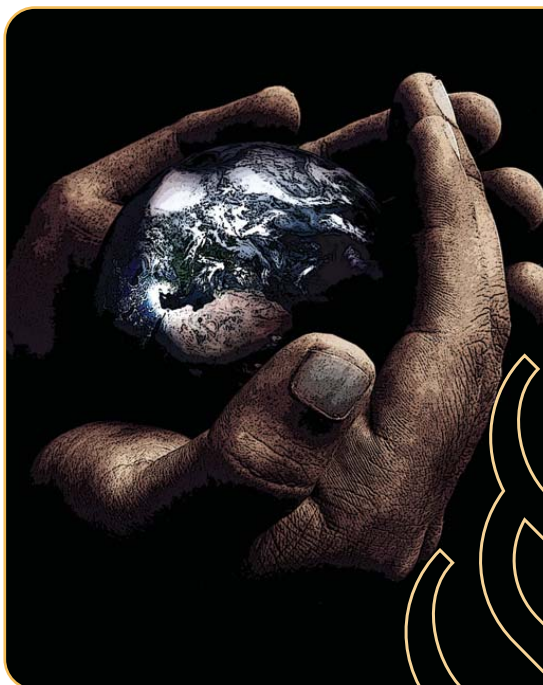

Erik Alexander de Boer was born in Alphen a/d Rijn, the Netherlands, in 1957. After his theological studies in Kampen and Tübingen (Germany) he served four congregations of the Reformed Churches. From 1990-93 he was minister in Pretoria before receiving promotion at the Université de Genève in 1999. His thesis was published in two volumes: John Calvin on the Visions of Ezekiel. Historical and Hermeneutical Studies in John Calvin's sermons inédits, especially on Ezek. 36-48 (Kerkhistorische Bijdragen, vol. 21) (Leiden: Brill Academic Publishers, 2004); Supplementa Calviniana, vol. X/3: Sermons sur le Livre des Revelations du prophete Ezechiel. Chapitres 36-48, ed. Erik A. de Boer - Barnabas Nagy † (Neukirchen-Vluyn: Neukirchener Verlag, 2006).

Currently he teaches Ecclesiology and Patristics at the Theological University in Kampen, the Netherlands, and is Affiliate Professor on the Chair of History of the Reformation at the Free University in Amsterdam. He also holds a honorary professorship of Reformatus Theologiai Academia of Sarospatak, Hungary. He recently published the critical edition of John Calvin's Epistolae duae (1537), prepared together with Dr. F.P. van Stam, forthcoming in June 2009 as COR 4/4. His current research is a critical edition and monograph on the 'congrégations', the weekly gathering of the Company of Pastors for the study of Scripture and discussion on doctrine as held in Geneva during the 16th century. A dossier of "disputations" from Geneva will be included.

Erik Alexander de Boer is gebore in 1957 in Alphen a/d Rijn, Nederland. Na sy teologiese studies in Kampen en Tübingen (Duitsland) het hy vier gemeentes van die Hervormde Kerke bedien. Van 1990-93 was hy predikant in Pretoria, voordat hy in 1999 aan die Université de Genève gepromoveer het. Sy tesis is in twee volumes gepubliseer: John Calvin on the Visions of Ezekiel. Historical and Hermeneutical Studies in John Calvin's sermons inédits, especially on Ezek. 36-48 (Kerkhistorische Bijdragen, vol. 21) (Leiden: Brill Academic Publishers, 2004); Supplementa Calviniana, vol. X/3: Sermons sur le Livre des Revelations du prophete Ezechiel. Chapitres 36-48, ed. Erik A. de Boer - Barnabas Nagy † (Neukirchen-Vluyn: Neukirchener Verlag, 2006).

Tans is hy lektor in Ekklesiologie en Patristiek aan die Teologiese Universiteit in Kampen, Nederland, sowel as geaffilieerde professor in die Leerstoel vir die Geskiedenis van die Hervorming aan die Vrye Universiteit van Amsterdam. Hy is ook ereprofessor aan die Reformatus Theologiai Academia in Sarospatak, Hongarye. Hy het onlangs 'n kritiese uitgawe van Johannes Calvin se Epistolae duae (1537) uitgereik, in samewerking met dr. F.P. van Stam, voorhande in Junie 2009 as COR 4/4. Tans fokus sy navorsing op 'n kritiese uitgawe en monografie van die 'congrégations', die weeklikse byeenkoms van die Geselskap van Pastore vir die bestudering van die Skrif en bespreking van die leerstellings wat die 16de eeu in Genève gegeld het. 'n Dossier van disputasies van Genève sal daarby ingesluit wees.
